Clarification on COVID-19 Restrictions


- Pennsylvania has no COVID-19 related restrictions for the delivery of (EI) services.
- El programs should be returning to normal operations.
- Engage families throughout El services to identify strategies that work for them.





Clarifications on COVID-19 Restrictions

- Stay current on and follow the CDC COVID-19 guidance
- Be sensitive to families' concerns
- Be sensitive to concerns of our early learning partners.
- Child care regulations require child care programs to make reasonable accommodations to include children with disabilities and IFSP/IEP and other behavioral support team members into child care programs

Update on Head Start & Vaccines

Q: Does the vaccine requirement apply to Part B/C providers (special education and related service providers for preschooler and infants and toddlers)?

A: No. These providers are not covered by the vaccine requirement. Part B/C providers are not considered staff of the Head Start program and there is no contractual relationship.


